

Greater Manchester Homelessness Action Network 3.3.2020

Results from workshop on priorities from the ten Greater Manchester boroughs

Please note: Stockport, Wigan and Leigh are in red as there was no attendance from either area, thus other attendees with knowledge of those areas filled them in.

It is important to note that the priorities selected from each area were heavily influenced by the organisations present at that table. This report highlights the most common themes across boroughs as local, GM/GMHAN and National considerations and ranks them in order of the number of times mentioned.

Local

Bolton

Local Action

- ABEN should be made available all year round
- All Bolton charities/organisations to admit that refused asylum seekers do exist and to put things in place to protect them
- Mental Health difficulties in accessing services
- Women nothing available for female asylum seekers if no availability with Boaz
- Nothing available for single men or women who are granted leave to remain

GM Action/Focus for GMHAN

• Consistent pathways for refused asylum seekers across the borough

National/Political

• More needs to be done to protect refused asylum seekers. These men and women are very vulnerable and there is not much available to protect them

Bury

Local Action

- Online list of accredited private landlords that accept DSS
- More partnership working between agencies
- Places for homeless to go on the evenings and weekends
- Daytime places that are safe and include activities
- Consistent offers food/services
- Consistent advice/expectation management

GM Action/Focus for GMHAN

- Co-production with service users
- Clearer pathways to support from the ABEN services
- Getting the correct people in meetings
- Consistent advice
- Promote good practice across all 10 GM boroughs

National/Political

- More social housing
- Rent control
- Allocate more LHA to match current rates

Manchester

Local Action

- Manchester (MHP) emergency accomodation action group vision to be implemented
- More accomodation for women and LGBTQ to be provided
- Mental Health lots more capacity needed in MH teams on the ground (previously had a MH housing team linked to the council in the 90's)
- Community building needed in order to prevent homelessness
- Local support (hubs, faith groups, safety nets)
- Preventative services aren't in place, meaning more people reaching crisis point.
